# 2024 Successes



#### Increase Economic Competitiveness

Launched the Integrated Mobility Center, providing training on infrastructure funding and engaging in development of passenger rail corridors in our region.



#### Improve Transportation Choices

Finalized region's first transportation demand management plan and launched CONNECT Centralina to promote transportation choices to replace drive-alone trips.



#### **Enhance Public Transit**

Seamless CONNECTions work advanced transit coordination for transit agencies and promoted a regional transportation guide for older adults, including ride share options.



### Promote Sustainable Regional Growth

Developed a guidebook for educating elected officials, planners and technical staff on integrating land use and transit planning.

# **Project Highlights**

# Launching Centralina's Integrated Mobility Center

Centralina's new Integrated Mobility Center launched in collaboration with regional transportation stakeholders with a focus on the following initiatives: (1) working with local Metropolitan Planning Organizations to respond to NCDOT Rail Division's recommended passenger rail corridors; and (2) begun work developing a Mobility Hub Implementation Strategy, a key recommendation of CONNECT Beyond.



# Launching CONNECT Centralina



In September, Centralina's Executive Board adopted the region's first Transportation Demand Management (TDM) Plan developed in collaboration with statewide and regional planning partners. CONNECT Centralina's TDM program will work to encourage alternatives to single occupancy vehicle (SOV) trips such as carpools, vanpools, walk/bike and public transit. CONNECT Centralina will focus on:

- **Education & Outreach** to major business, healthcare and education centers.
- **Regional Partnerships & Coordination** that encourage employer-led TDM programs.
- **Incentives & Facilitation** for non-SOV travel.
- **Technical Assistance to s**upport the development of TDM policies and regulations.

## **Creating Seamless CONNECTions**

Project partners are working to increase coordination and promote seamless connections across the region by:



Advancing transit coordination opportunities between transit agencies, including CATS's work under an NCDOT ConCPT grant to streamline trip planning and transfers with adjacent transit agencies.

**Convening the Mobility Management Group** to facilitate inter-agency solutions and share best practices and trainings for public transportation agencies in the region.

**Launching the first microtransit systems** to increase efficiency, frequency and accessibility of first/last mile connections with Go Gastonia and Southpark Community Partner's Skipper service.



# **Regional Coordination: ATP Committee**

CONNECT Beyond's Advancing the Plan Committee was established to steward regional conversation and plan implementation. Committee members including elected officials, city and county managers and members of the business community, met throughout 2023 and early 2024 with the goal of shaping recommendations for a regional mobility governance approach. In 2024, the Committee completed their final report and included recommendations related to organizational models for regional collaboration. **FINAL REPORT**

- Continue implementation of CATS' ConCPT grant from NCDOT to improve transit coordination and create seamless transfers. ONGOING
- Continue to expand transit education and awareness for older adults and people with disabilities. ONGOING
- Launch CONNECT Centralina, the region's first transportation demand management program. SUMMER 2025
- With Charlotte Regional Transportation Planning Organization, engage and educate communities about best practices for developing mobility hubs. FALL 2025
- The Centralina Integrated Mobility Center will **develop a Mobility Hub Playbook** and work with communities in the region to identify and implement mobility hub pilot design projects. **SUMMER 2025**
